Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on **Thursday 4 July 2024**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on **Wednesday 26 June 2024**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on **Wednesday 26 June 2024**.
